


TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

NOW on this 23RD day of February, 2017, this matter comes before this honorable Court upon the request of Plaintiffs Paul Barton and Cynthia Donohue, and it appearing to the Court that upon the facts alleged in said request, Plaintiffs Barton and Donohue are entitled to immediate relief prayed for; and it further appearing that said Plaintiffs may suffer irreparable harm, damage and injury unless the Defendant(s) are restrained forthwith:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Defendant(s) named herein, and their agents, servants and all persons acting by or through or under their authority be and are hereby enjoined and restrained from ordering and/or holding any new election pertaining to the offices of Chief of the Seneca-Cayuga Nation and First Committee Person of the Seneca-Cayuga Nation, until this matter is resolved or until further order of the Court.
