The Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor Specialist must possess the skills necessary for assessment, diagnostic, treatment planning, treatment and evaluation of treatment of individuals with substance abuse. Applicant must have a working knowledge of mental health counseling techniques, treatment procedures, and knowledge of associated resources including case management, vocational and educational placement. Applicant must have experience in counseling couples and families, and be able to recognize related problem areas and offer alternatives in problem solving. Applicants should have the demonstrated ability to establish a working rapport with clients and create an atmosphere of trust and change. In addition, the applicant must have knowledge of culture and beliefs of Native Americans in this area and the ability to incorporate these beliefs in the recovery of client and family when appropriate. Applicant must affirm in writing that his/her employment performance has not been impaired by alcohol/drug addiction in the last seven (7) years.
