This position will assist in all programs and projects of the Environmental Services Department as directed by the Environmental Director. Duties will include but not be limited to the following: field data collection, data entry, processing analysis and reporting under the Seneca Cayuga Nation's Water Quality Monitoring Program. Will review scientific studies and proposals, wetland identification and delineation, water and sediment sampling and testing, assessment and reporting. May also be utilized in the NRDAR Program and participate in several tribal consortia regarding NRDAR. Other duties may include adding support to the Recycling, Open Dump Remediation, Indoor Air Quality Monitoring, Climate Change Adaptation, GIS, and any other programs the Environmental Department may engage in. Experience in Water Quality Monitoring under EPA's Tribal CWA 106 program will be an advantage as well as competency in basic scientific principles involved with water chemistry, biology and toxic substances. Other required competencies include keyboarding/data entry, Microsoft Office applications including Excel, Word and Outlook. Must have the physical ability to negotiate steep stream banks, wade shallow creeks and conduct sampling on a moving boat and lift up to fifty pounds.
