**Seneca-Cayuga Nation COVID-19
Technology Assistance Program
November 1, 2020 – December 15, 2020
(Pre-K – 12th Grade, Including Homeschool)**

The COVID-19 Technology Assistance Program is being offered to equip all enrolled students from Pre-K to 12th grade with technological tools that will better enable distance learning necessitated by COVID-19. All eligible students, who are enrolled tribal citizens, will receive a one-time \$500.00 allowance. This emergency program is created specifically to keep our tribal youth safe by providing a means to stay at home and still obtain an education, if needed.

The funds from the COVID-19 Technology Assistance Program may be used for one or more of the following items, including but not limited to: Laptop/Desktop Computer, Tablet, Wi-fi/Hotspot, Microsoft Office/Educational Software, Printer/Scanner/Copier or any other technology related resources. The receipts for these items must be retained by the recipient for a five-year period so they are available if they need to be produced for the Seneca-Cayuga Nation or Department of Treasury.

The eligibility for this program includes all students in grades Pre-K through 12th grade, including those being homeschooled. A copy of membership card and proof of enrollment will need to be attached to the application. Proof of enrollment would include a letter on school letterhead or a letter certifying the student is enrolled in homeschooling. If Youth Fellowship Fund was applied for and received, you must only submit Technology Assistance Program Application as membership card and Proof of Enrollment are on file. Applications must be received by the Seneca-Cayuga Nation by December 15, 2020.

The applications for the COVID-19 Technology Assistance Program will be processed as they are received. If the application is missing required documentation you will be contacted to provide the information before application process proceeds.
