<u>General Statement of Responsibility:</u> The Food Service Worker is responsible for preparing and serving fresh food items, maintaining cleanliness and sanitation standards, and providing excellent customer service in a convenience store setting. This role supports the overall food and beverage operations and ensures customers receive fast, friendly, and quality service.

Specific Areas of Responsibility:

- Prepares and cooks food items according to recipes and food safety standards (e.g., sandwiches, hot dogs, grab-and-go items, simple breakfast/lunch).
- Operates kitchen equipment (grills, fryers, coffee makers, etc.).
- Maintains cleanliness and sanitation of the kitchen, food preparation areas, and dining spaces.
- Monitors food temperatures and ensures proper holding times.
